



Event Details for the Share the Music Challenge 2003

Share the Music Challenge 2003 includes a concert, the "Play to Win" music challenge, and a raffle of great prizes including the grand prize: a Roland electric piano valued at \$3,000.00 and donated by Sherman Clay (formerly Moe's Pianos). Proceeds from this event will help support the sponsoring music programs.

The Concert

This year's concert features outstanding student performers who participate in programs sponsored by the **Piano Santa Foundation (PSF)** and the **South West Music School (SWMS)**. One of these accomplished young musicians has already received national recognition. The concert is free to the public and will be held Saturday, May 17, 2003 at 2:00 pm in the auditorium of the Southminster Presbyterian Church located at 12250 SW Denney Rd. (at the corner of Denney Rd. and Hall Blvd. in Beaverton, OR).

How to Win Prizes

Results of the drawing for the recipient of the grand prize piano will be announced at the concert. If the winner is not present, he or she will be notified by phone. Once the grand prize has been awarded, smaller prizes will be awarded to ticket holders in the audience via a random drawing. Remember, there are two ways you can enter to win the prizes:

- **Take the challenge**
- **Purchase a ticket**

Additional tickets can be purchased at the door.

The Challenge

"Play to Win" is the name of this year's Challenge. The challenge is to see how much you can learn. Here's how to participate:

Set aside a period of two weeks for dedicated practice on an instrument of your choice. Think about how much time you normally practice during a week and challenge yourself to practice more often. How many new pieces might you be able to learn in this two week period?

Before you start practicing, get a couple of people to sponsor you. Collect pledges from friends and family totaling \$5.00 or more. The more pledges you receive, the more times your name is entered into the drawing for the prizes. Collect \$25.00, for example, and have your name entered five times.

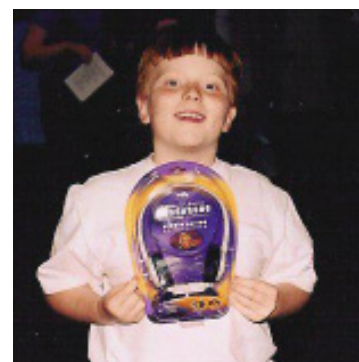
Once you are ready, begin the Challenge! Record your practice hours on the entry form. At the end of two weeks, collect your pledge money, then have your parents write a check payable to the Piano Santa Foundation, and send it in with your entry form to PSF, PO Box 80173, Portland, OR 97280 postmarked no later than May 5, 2003. (Tracking chart and pledge form are printed on the other side of this letter.)

Both PSF and SWMS are not-for-profit organizations that benefit many students in the Portland Metro area and offer music scholarships to families who need assistance. This is a needed resource for music given the current economic conditions.
